

STATISTICS FOR 2021-2022

NURSING CARE PROGRAM

- **8** Registered nurses managing:
- **129** Palliative care, oncology and ALS clients on average
- **397** Clients in total (361 with cancer + 9 with ALS + 27 other palliative clients)
- **148** New clients
- **2,387** Home nursing visits
- **1,534** Phone nursing assessments
- **8,794** Hours of services (visits, phone calls, references)
 - **67** Home deaths

BEREAVEMENT PROGRAM

Carousel

- Youths and children received services/counselling (65 visits)
- **9** Adults received services/counselling (60 visits)

Adult Bereavement

- 8-week individualized phone counselling sessions for **16** bereaved adults
- **2** 8-week support groups in physical presence for **10** bereaved adults

ADULT DAY CENTERS PROGRAM

- 4 Adult Day Centers closed/transformed virtually in November 2020
- **2,695** Activity workbooks sent out (74 different themes)
- **4,062** Attendance from members + **988** from caregivers + **1,483** from volunteers
 - 17 Members received in-home stimulation = 327 visits
 - **298** Days of services
- **3,646** Hours of services from virtual and in-home visits

HOME SUPPORT PROGRAM

- **8** Home Health Aides
- **25** Clients received services
- **1,012** Visits
- **5,704** Hours worked

VOLUNTEER PROGRAM

- **3,534*** Hours donated by **185** active volunteers
 - **19** Hours in palliative or cancer care home visits (2 visits + 24 phone visits)
 - **2,960** Hours in transportation (**1,245** rides)
 - **505** Hours done in Adult Day Centers
 - **50** Hours in administrative work
